PASTORAL ANNUAL REPORT FOR 2015

Dear Trinity Family,

My heart echoes the words of Paul in his letter to the people of Phillipi.

Phillipians 1:3-6

3 I thank my God every time I remember you. **4** In all my prayers for all of you, I always pray with joy **5** because of your partnership in the gospel from the first day until now, **6** being confident of this, that he who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus.

I am so very grateful for your support, encouragement and extension of grace as we begin ministry together. The highlight of 2015 was when I entered into a ministry partnership with both Trinity churches. I remember leaving the church after I met the call committee for Truman and felt the sense of call and God being at work in the midst of the process. I believe that the partnership is a responsible stewardship decision for both congregations BUT I also believe that this partnership has the possibility far beyond budgeting but to have an impact in the Kingdom of God. The question I am posing for both congregations in the coming year is how is this partnership impacting God's Kingdom beyond our walls?

Looking ahead to 2016 -

In the last few months it has been a challenge for me to find a balance in my weekly schedule. In trying to provide pastoral care for those in crisis, office work and worship planning, emergency calls, and my own personal illness – visitation for shut-ins has not been where I would like it to be and is a goal for the coming year. I enjoy doing visitations and look forward to making this happen on a regular basis.

Worship is the heart of our life together. Worship is where we encounter God through Word and Sacrament and equips us to live out our faith. It is during worship we are reminded of who we are as beloved Children of God - forgiven people called to be workers together in God's Kingdom. Sermon series for the year include: Prayer (Lent) and The Greatest Story (in the fall).

Faith formation for all ages is the work of the church. I am looking forward to working together with you on how we can live out our faith. We grow in faith through study, prayer, worship and service. We currently have 7 students total (5 Truman and 2 Madelia) who currently meet once a month for an extended class times.

This change has allowed the class to dig deeper, have fun, and a time for fellowship. One of the highlights has been a 103 year old guest that shared her faith story when we studied Communion. Upcoming themes include: The Lord's Prayer during Lent (coordinated with our worship series in Lent), 10 Commandments, and Luther. This fall, in conjunction with The Greatest Story series, our confirmation students will begin the year of studying the Bible.

I am very excited for the two mission trips this summer. In addition to the Youth trip, Trinity will be going on a Family Mission Trip. This trip is a great opportunity for our youngest members and our members with more life experience to serve together and grow in their faith by serving others.

I am so grateful to all who lead, serve, and worship here at Trinity. A special thank you to Brenda, Barb, and Lowell for all they do each and every week to support the ministry at Trinity.

Trinity President's Report

If you have ever enjoyed looking at the flowers or decorations, accidentally spilled something, sang a hymn, read the bulletin, been inspired by the choir, attended the Cookie walk or other fundraiser, or sent your children to Sunday School and Vacation Bible School, you can be sure that someone planned and prepared for those things to happen. I have seen people working at the church at all hours. These people have put off their meals or made arrangements for child care to spend time at church during the week and some do not even turn in the receipts for the things they purchase. I appreciate all of you who helped get things done this year. The thing that we all can do for the good of Trinity is pray. Pray for each other, pray for your family, pray for our church, and the town, state and country. If you have a few seconds, you can pray, and if you have hours to spare, think of the difference your prayers could make!

1 Timothy 2:1-2 "First of all, then, I urge that supplications, prayers, intercessions, and thanksgivings be made for all people." Romans 12:12 "Rejoice in hope, be patient in tribulation, be constant in prayer."

Trinity has a wonderful opportunity with the addition of Pastor Krista Strum. Her husband Matt, and children Katherine and Lauren have been involved in services by reading and singing. I feel we have had a rejuvenation of sermons, liturgy, and atmosphere. We are contracting with Madelia Trinity, so while this is different than the partnership we had with Waverly, it is a strong connection. It has been a pleasure getting to know the people of Madelia Trinity, and working with them to make plans for the fall, Christmas and Lent. Our two councils meet together every month and communication is key to the success of our congregations. Thank you to the call committee for working to bring Pastor Krista to Trinity. Our church also has two wonderful employees, Brenda Hanson, Office Administrator and Lowell Noorlun, custodian. Thank you for your dedication.

Matthew 18:20 "For where two or three are gathered in my name, there am I among them."

There are some challenges ahead for Trinity:

*We currently have a 50%-50% contract with Madelia Trinity. We have extended our budget above the pledged amount, so we will need to continue receiving enough in offerings to pay all

of our bills. One way to reach this goal is for everyone to give what they can and specifically, to honor their pledge. We also hope to have our membership grow in the coming year. This is a leap of faith to trust God to fulfill our church's needs, but God expects us to live out our faith and ask Him for help.

John 14:13-14

"Whatever you ask in my name, this I will do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. If you ask me anything in my name, I will do it."

*We must continue to give help to those who plan Sunday School and Youth group activities. A strong church needs families and God-centered activities for these young people to do. Parents certainly, should volunteer or agree to help when asked, but helpers can be of any age. The Education and Youth board members have a heavy load, so our support and hands are needed. The sounds of children in church should be welcome, even if they cry or make a noise during worship.

Luke 18:16 "But Jesus called them to him, saying, 'Let the children come to me, and do not hinder them; for to such belongs the kingdom of God.' "

*I challenge those who are critical of decisions, ideas, and changes when the Pastor, council or a board has acted, to step up and get involved. Being a leader isn't as easy as it looks, and there are many considerations that you may not be aware of. If you have a comment, please go to the appropriate person or board with your concerns. It is easy to complain, but comments made in public that are positive will bring more members to our congregation and a relationship with Christ. I have faith in the new officers and council for 2016. A team effort is the best way to get things done. Are you a team player?

Hebrews 10:24-25 "And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works, not neglecting to meet together, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near."

***The furnace fund continues** to grow slowly. Our furnaces are working, but there will need to be a replacement in the future. Prayerfully consider if you can contribute to this fund.

Finally, I encourage you to go deeper into your relationship with God. Read your bible, pray, attend church, and bring your children/grandchildren to the house of the Lord. God bless Trinity and God bless you all.

It wasn't a very busy year for division work. Three divisions had one work session each and the fourth division did not have any assignments, so it was decided to leave the chairperson assignments the same for next year with the exception of one member. Thank you to everyone who helped throughout the year.

A big thank you to our dedicated quilters who made approximately 110 quilts. Thank you also for the donations of fabric, batting and backing materials used to make the quilts. Two quilts were also made for our graduating seniors, Ciera Drevlow and Emily Zaharia. The quilters met the last Monday and Tuesday of January and February to make the quilts and enjoy fellowship, good coffee breaks and noon lunch. The quilts were donated to Bridging, Inc. in the Twin Cities who distributed them to kids and adults in need of a warm and comforting quilt. Thanks to Darrell and Janice Buhmann for delivering the quilts.

Other activities during the last year included the Salad Luncheon in June, the Thankoffering Service in November and our 20th Cookie Walk in December.

Eight times last year a group of ladies went to either Truman or Madelia nursing homes and assisted with Bingo. We also did mending at Truman Senior Living and helped sponsor a birthday party in September for the residents of Luther Memorial Home in Madelia.

Our ongoing activities include Prayer Project Lifesaver (praying for and supporting our youth), Equal Exchange Coffee project, the summer coffee hours, the mitten tree (a HUGE thank you goes to JoAnn Knutson for making so many knitted hats and mittens each year), and the recycled greeting card project. Money from the card project for 2015 was given to the mini golf course project by the swimming pool for continued expansion.

In addition to WELCA involvement, we still have two Circles. Members of the Martha Circle meet in homes and a joint-circle Bible study with the Lois Circle is held the first Thursday of

each month at the Truman Café . The primary purpose of Circle is Bible study but we all enjoy the fellowship as well. Service projects of the Circles include giving each baptized child at Trinity a baby quilt or book, donating baby quilts and money to Options Pregnancy Center and donating to the Toys for Tots program.
