Dear Trinity Faith Family,



We began a prayer practice with our children called **Praying in Color**. We are using a Praying in Color pattern to help us countdown to Easter. Before we begin on normal prayers of worship we pause with the children and have them begin our prayer time reflecting on who Jesus is. We have been encouraged to think about what

we know, how would we describe Jesus in our gospel lesson, what words can we find in scripture, or the ask the congregation option (which by the way the children haven't used much). Have you paid attention to some of the words our children have given us? Here are a few...

love - forgiveness- **persistent -** complex - friend - powerful - **compassionate -** compulsive

If you get a chance take a moment to look at the prayer poster that is coming together. As we prepare to enter Holy Week we will continue to add words...I wonder what words we will hear out of the mouths of our children as they hear the story of Jesus entering Jerusalem, of Jesus sharing the Last Supper with his disciples, of Jesus in the Garden, or on trial, or on the cross. I invite you to take some time to think of words you would use to describe Jesus during these events and join us for worship on Sundays, Wednesdays and Holy Week as we continue to reflect on who Jesus is.

Brad called the meeting to order.

The secretary's report was read and approved. Clayton made the motion and Nikki made the second. Clayton presented the treasurer's report. There is \$11,984 in the checking account and \$37,318 in the savings account. Barb made the motion to accept the report and Cathy made the second. Motion carried.

BOARD REPORTS:

Stewardship: Duane presented information that Vern had collected concerning insurance on the church. The motion was granted to accept the bid from Profinium and Grinnell Mutual for \$3666.

It was decided to deliver the food collected at church to Heaven's Table and Salvation Army.

Lay ministry: There will be a Maundy Thursday service and coffee on April 13.

Church properties: The new heating system seems to be working well. Brad and Doyle fixed the tree in the front of the church. Brad plans to plant more evergreens on the east side of the church. He will also install a light that will illuminate the cross

Christian education: The Sunday School kids have begun working on a play/musical that they will present to the congregation on April 30.

Youth: The League will be serving two Lenten suppers and the Easter breakfast on April 16.

Worship: The WELCA will be hosting the Spring Gathering on April 8. The choir will be participating in the Festival of Songs on March 12

Pastor Krista: Confirmation youth and several parents participated in the Kids Against Hunger event in Fairmont. All were highly motivated to do it again next vear. Confirmation will be held on May 7th. Our confirmands are Tallin Cook, Carson Peters, and Miah Krebs. Trinity Madelia has offered to pay 1/2 of our camper fees. This is a very generous offer: the cost of camp is \$490 per camper. The adult study group is going well. Mission trips are coming up in June and July.



Old business:

The council will be hosting a coffee/fund raiser after the play on April 30. The free will offering will help with the financial expenses for the campers.

New business:

It was decided that Laurie Wille be given permission to use the fellowship hall on Saturday, April 15th.

Other discussion items:

JESUS IS RISEN!

When Jesus' disciples saw that the stone was rolled away from his tomb, they knew he had risen. Make a moveable tomb to celebrate Easter.

What you need:

- 4 pieces of paper (brown, blue, black, yellow)
- Scissors
- Pencil
- · Glue stick
- · Brad fastener
- Marker



- Fold the brown paper in half, short side to short side. Cut along the fold. On one half, draw and cut out a large half-circle (the tomb). On the other, draw and cut out a palmsized circle (the stone).
- Glue the brown tomb onto the blue paper.
- Cut a black circle (the inside of the tomb) the same size as the brown stone and glue it onto the brown tomb.
- Place the brown stone over the black half-circle; this is the entrance. Push the brad through one edge so the stone can move from side to side.
- Cut out a cross from the yellow paper and glue it by the tomb.
- Write "Jesus is risen!" atop the blue paper.
















How did God work through Jesus to give us new life at Easter?

Christian Symbol+

Agnus Dei

This image is known as the Agnus Dei, Latin for "Lamb of God." When pictured standing and with a banner, it represents the risen Christ, victorious over death. John the Baptist, seeing Jesus approach, famously declared, "Look, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world!" (John 1:29, NIV). In Revelation, too, Jesus is portrayed as a lamb who was slain but now reigns triumphant.
