Dear Trinity Faith Family,

The season of Lent is a time when we draw closer to God by doing certain prac-

tices that help us to focus on God in new ways in our lives. Many Christians observe

the season of lent by giving up something for the 40 days of lent.

I encourage you this year to consider instead of giving up something for lent - take time to pray... pray more... or explore different ways to pray. Prayer is a faith practice that sustains us in our Christian faith. Jesus gave us the Lord's Prayer as a model prayer to

teach his disciples to pray. Join us on Sundays, as we dig deeper into this prayer. What does it mean and how can praying this prayer change our lives?

On Wednesdays, we will borrow wisdom of Henri Nowen's book - *With Open Hands*. Together we will look at the practice of pray-

er, the barriers, and how it changes us. We will also explore simple prayer exercises and practices we can take home and use in our personal, couple, and family prayer times.

One other option for lenten practice is to consider being part of an Adult Faith Education opportunity being offered at Trinity in Madelia. The course is called, *The Gifts of*

Imperfection, by Brene
Brown. Ash Wednesday we will be reminded of our humanity - hearing the words "Remember you are dust and to dust you shall return." Join us for this class where we together acknowledge that even in our humanity, our imperfections - in Christ we are enough. We are beloved Children of God. You are invited to be a part of this class.

Trinity Council Minutes January 13, 2016

We first met with Trinity Madelia, Pastor Krista was home with the flu. The times for Lenten Services were discussed with tentative times of Ash Wednesday service to be 5:30 at Truman and 7:00 at Madelia. It was also decided to alternate Lenten services with Madelia and Trinity Truman would have Feb. 17, March 2 & March 16th with the suppers at 5:30 and Service at 7:00. Maundy Thursday service at Truman will be that morning at 9:30am with communion and coffee & rolls to follow and Madelia will hold the evening service. Good Friday Service would be held in Truman at 7:00pm. Easter Sunday will start with breakfast before church and the service will be at 10:30am. The worship committee will be meeting with Pastor Krista to firm everything up on Friday, January 15th.

President Laurie Willie called the Trinity Truman council meeting to order.

The Secretary's report from Dec.

9th was reviewed and with the changes of Barb Mager being present at the meeting and it was an IPad that was purchased to tape the sermons. Motion passed with the changes.

Clayton presented the Treasurers report. There is \$14,239 in checking and \$71,195 in savings. It was also noted that we are \$5800 ahead at year end. The dollars in Thanksgiving and Christmas offerings was discussed on where they could be used. It was decided that the council would like to keep the donations local and get the youth and children involved in their donation. It was tabled until next month.

<u>Lay Ministry</u>: The poinsettias have been all cleaned up and a thank you on how great they looked up front.

Church Properties: Brad reported that the lights are being changed out to more energy efficient bulbs as they become available. There should be 80% less energy being used with the new LED bulbs. He is also checking with the gas company for rebates toward the heating project.

<u>Christian Ed:</u> Nikki reported that they are continuing with the Sunday school program as before the Christmas break.

Youth: Teresa reported that the youth had decorated cookies and watched a movie in December. They are still working on finding a charity that will take the books that were donated by the school library. If anyone has a suggestion, please contact Teresa.

Worship: Barb reported that we will be holding separate council meetings on Ash Wednesday. If anyone is interested in carpooling to the Lenten services in Madelia, contact Barb. A discussion was

held on getting the youth

more involved in church activities such as lighting candles & reading the psalms. We need to get the youth to express what they would like to see in church & worship services.

Old Business: A reminder that there is a need for updated phone information from the congregation. In the back of the Annual report is a list of all members and the phone numbers that we have now, if yours has changed, please let Brenda know.

Installation of Pastor Krista, the Lay ministry will be getting together with Pastor Krista to see how she wants to handle this.

New Business: Clayton has purchased the new phones for the church at a cost of \$225 with \$200 being donations and \$25 from the church. Brad will help Clayton get them installed and programmed.

It was also mentioned that anyone who is donating items to the church as a tax write-off, they really need to submit a bill & then when they get paid, they can return the check to the church. 


Brené Brown, Ph.D., L.M.S.


