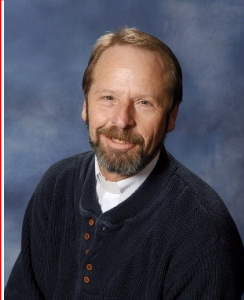

CALL COMMITTEE

TRINITY CALL COMMITTEE UPDATE

The Trinity call committee interviewed the Reverend Krista Strum, currently serving at Word of Peace Lutheran Church in Rogers, MN, in early June. Each member of the committee was left with an overwhelmingly positive feeling for Pastor Strum at meeting's end.

Prior to Luther Seminary, Pastor Strum received a Master's degree in education with an emphasis on special education. Since seminary she has served several congregations and has been at Word of Peace since 2011. On her resume, she lists her areas of expertise as Christian education and youth and family ministry. She considers her areas of strength to be teaching, innovation and creativity.

Pastor Strum has been officially called by Trinity Lutheran Church in Madelia, which is seeking to partner with another parish to contract for part of Rev. Strum's time. Trinity of Truman is seeking to contract for 40-50% of Rev. Strum's time. The financial details and exact structure of her service with Trinity Truman are yet to be finalized. She is scheduled to begin at Trinity Madelia in mid-July. Should this scenario go ahead, the call committee would like her service to start at Truman around September 1.

A congregational meeting Sunday, June 14, gave Truman members an opportunity to hear from the call committee. Videos of Rev. Strum giving a children's sermon and a regular sermon were shown to the group. Comments about her from folks after that meeting were very positive. The meeting was called to order by President Laurie Wille. Vicar Kent led us in devotions.

Marlene read the May 13th minutes and approve them with a couple minor word changes.

Clayton presented the Monthly Treasurers report, checking balance is \$5,424 and Savings Balance is



\$52,832. It was also noted that for the second

month we have a negative balance, as the cash available was \$5242 and the Bills to pay were \$6726 leaving us with a negative amount of \$1302. Another reminder will be sent out in the bulletin that we need to keep up with our pledges. Another item he wanted members to be aware of is to please shut all lights off when leaving the church, especially check the bathroom ones.

Christian Ed: Nikki noted that they are going to start working on Vacation Bible School and will be contacting Thrivent with the help of Yvonne to secure a grant to help with the cost.

Worship: Barb reported they are making ribbon markers for the hymnals to mark where the Psalms start.

Vicar Kent: He gave an update on

Lisa's health. He is working

on an Approval Essay for Seminary & Synod interviews. He is also making visits with members that have not been coming to church, and continues to visit members that are sick or shut-ins.

Macaroni Salad

Ingredients:

- 1 box (16 oz.) macaroni pasta
- 1 small yellow onion diced
- 1/2 green pepper seeded and diced
- 1/2 red pepper seeded and diced
- 1 cup diced celery
- 2 cups mayonnaise
- 1 (14oz) can sweetened condensed milk
- 1/2 cup sugar
- 1/2 cup white vinegar
- salt and pepper to taste

While pasta is cooking start chopping up all the veggies. After pasta is done I rinse with cool water for a few seconds so after I put in all of the ingredients it does not take as long to set up in the fridge Mix all of the ingredients into the pasta cover and put in fridge until it thickens up. Sometimes it looks really liquidy when you put everything together, but that is ok, it will thicken up in the fridge.

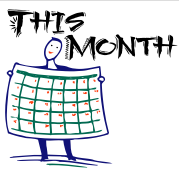

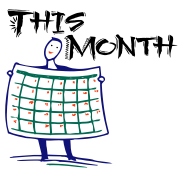

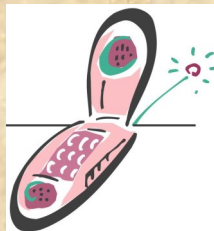

During 2014-15, the synod's Lutheran Men in Mission (LMM) provided \$8,500 for seminary tuition scholarships; \$9,730 is available for 2015-16. Recipients will have an openness and commitment to future service in rural settings. The profit from the LMM golf tournament goes into the LMM Rural Ministry Fund to help grow leaders. Besides the proceeds from the golf tournament, LMM also has an ELCA Fund for Leaders Endowment Fund which generates investment income for the scholarships. Since its inception, this endowment has awarded scholarships of \$77,825 for seminary tuition.

After a busy summer day, relax in the shade with this cool drink.

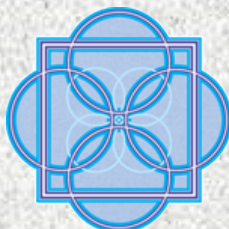


What you need:

Quatrefoil

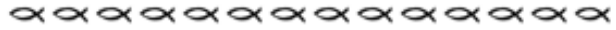
