
You see, last night we were in the center of a severe storm and found ourselves in a Peace to you in the name of Christ safe zone (in a very small hot, humid, stinky





June 5th, 2016. His funeral was held at St. John Vianney Catholic Church in Fairmont, MN on June 10th, 2016.




