President Tom Dodge called the meeting to order. Pastor Krista lead the group with devotions.

The secretary's report was read and approved.

Clayton presented the treasurer's report. There is \$11,672 in the checking account and \$71,637 in the savings account.

#### **BOARD REPORTS:**

Stewardship: Duane reported that he has made 2 trips the last few weeks to deliver food to our church families. He suggested that paper products such as toilet paper, paper towels, garbage bags, paper plates, cups

& silverware would also be appreciated.

<u>Lay Ministry</u>: They have cards and gifts ready for all the confirmand's and graduates.

Church Properties: Brad and Dennis are still working on getting bids for the heating system. Day Plumbing as put in a bid along with the amount of the rebates and the efficiency of the unit. Brad will check back with Watsons this week, and if they are unable to furnish a system, It was decided to go ahead with Day Plumbing. Brad also reported that 6 new evergreens have been planted on the east side of the church and there will be more planted in memory of Sylvan Behrens. Also Doyle will be fertilizing the lawn.

## Starting on July 3rd our church service starts at 8:45 for the next year.

<u>Christian Education</u>: Sunday school is over and they are now working with Pastor Krista to plan for Vacation Bible School.

<u>Worship</u>: Confirmation service will be May 15th and Graduation Sunday will be May 22 with a Brunch served after the service. A reminder that starting July 3rd our church service starts at 8:45 for a year.

### JUNE WELCA NEWS

The quarterly WELCA meeting was held on May 9th. Rob Stauter, a CREST board member, gave a presentation about the CREST program in Martin County. CREST was formed by a group of clergy, congregational members and human service providers who saw a need for helping older adults. CREST began as a volunteer program in 1997 and expanded to Martin County in 2003. Truman began receiving services in January of 2015. In Truman presently there are 15 volunteers and 6-9 people needing help. Rob passed out a brochure about CREST and asked that we spread the word about the help that is available and the opportunities for our members to volunteer.

Our WELCA group received money through Thrivent to make fleece blankets. Ten fleece blankets were made that man Senior Living will be donated to Lutheran World Relief. Also 15 school kits will be donated. Thank vou to Janice Buhmann and Norma Stough for making the sturdy back-pack bags which

have school supplies in them. These bags will also be donated to Lutheran World Relief. In addition the guilts that were made in January – March will be donated to "Bridging" which gives blan-

kets to families in need. Thank you to everyone who helped with these projects.

It was decided to have coffee hours during the summer hours. Coffee hours in June will be from 9:00 a.m. until 10:15 a.m. Because we will start church earlier in July for the next year, the coffee hours will be held after church. Proceeds from the coffee hours will be used to help finance the polka service in October. The proceeds from the auction go to helping Green Lake Bible Camp.





- Crayons or paint


#### What you do:

## Christian Symbol+ APPLE



Although Genesis 3 doesn't identify the forbidden fruit eaten by Adam and Eve, it has traditionally been thought of and portrayed as an apple. This may be because in Latin, "apple" and "evil" are the same word (malum). An apple, then, often represents humanity's fall into sin. When Christ is shown holding an apple, however, it symbolizes his conquest over sin and death. "for as in Adam all die, so in Christ all will be made alive" (1 Corinthians 15:22, Niv).
