Vice president Grant called the meeting to order. The secretary's report was approved as read.

Clayton presented the treasurer's report. There is \$5162 in the checking account and \$49,627 in the savings account. There was a net loss of \$1242 in the month of April. Lately we have had several months with net losses. Members are encouraged to honor their pledges. Cathy made the motion to accept the report and Britta made the second. Motion carried.

BOARD REPORTS:

Stewardship--Bags of food were delivered to the Salvation Army.

Lay ministry--Our confirmands received gifts from the congregation. The graduates will receive a quilt from WELCA that was made especially for them.

Church properties--A new motion light has been installed above the back door. A sign designated for pastor's parking will be installed on the south side of the building. Several handicapped parking signs will also be put on the south side. Dan and Nikki Smith will be painting the cross sometime this summer. Putting more rock on the south parking lot was tabled.

Christian education--The youth service on April 29 went well. No decision has been made concerning VBS.
