## Walking with Jesus - Living Lives of Gratitude!

Count your blessings... name them one by one... Count your many blessings see what God has done...

As a young child, I remember my grandmother and my mother singing this catchy little tune. I liked this

tune as a child because it was a catchy tune... but as an adult I like this song for its words because it gives some solid words of wisdom. The wisdom of counting our blessings and being grateful for the abundant blessings each one of us have received.

When I was on internship, my supervisor loved to keep me on my toes and see if I could think on the spot. Wednesday night children's worship was no exception. I would get to church in the evening and then he would give me a verse to teach to the children in a way they could understand. Pastor Rob thought he had me stumped on one particular Wednesday night with John 10:10. I (Jesus) came that you (all of us) may have life and have it abundantly.

The children came for worship and we talked about the word abundant. IT was the day after Halloween and we talked about how much candy they had gotten trick -o-treating the night before... did they get a little or did the bags overflow abundantly. We showed abundantly with our arms open wide and yelling — "Abundantly!"

God's love for us overflows ABUNDANTLY! But so often instead of living aware of this abundance we get sucked into a scarcity mentality promoted by the news, social media, and commercials. We become painfully aware of what we don't have... and then begin to cling to what we have... that is not the life that Jesus has come to give us...

Walking with Jesus - living lives abundantly — involves living lives of GRATITUDE. In the book One Thousand Gifts, Ann Voskamp asks the question "How

do we find joy in the midst of deadlines, debt, drama, and daily duties? What does a life of gratitude look like when your days are gritty, long, and sometimes dark? Voskamp discovers and shares that the practice of gratitude — waking up each day practicing an awareness to God's everyday blessings. She found that in giving thanks for the life she already had, she found the life she'd always wanted.

So, for the month of November, I invite you in practicing GRATITUDE this month.

- 1) If you haven't read One Thousand Gifts by Ann Voskamp read it. If you've read it... read it again!
- 2) Make time during the day... to keep a gratitude list... Write down 2-3 things you are grateful for... even if (especially if) life is challenging right now.
- 3) As you think about your financial giving this year, consider the many blessings you have received and how you can give thanks to God through your offerings at church to God and God's work. Prayerfully consider increasing your giving by a 1% of your income or consider increasing it by a cup a coffee or a meal eaten out a week.
- 4) As you come to worship in November... be ready to offer a prayer of gratitude at the GRATITUDE box". It will be easy... I promise... just be thinking of something you are thankful for.
- 5) Finally, when someone asks you, "How are you?" instead of responding with an automatic "I am fine" respond with "I'm grateful" and if someone responds with "I'm grateful" to you take a moment for a personal connection and ask "What are you especially grateful for today?"

I am grateful for the parishioner that responded to me Sunday with "I'm grateful"

- Thank you for reminding me of the many blessing in my life.

Let us together Walk with Jesus! Living lives of Gratitude. Let's Count Our Blessings!

### Trinity Church Council Minutes October 14, 2015

Trinity of Madelia met with us and watched a video on Stewardship Mission, Pastor Krista brought up the Thanksgiving service and it was decided that she would be at Trinity in Truman on Wednesday, November 25th for a 7:00pm service with Communion. It was also decided that she would do the Christmas Eve service at Truman at 5:30pm and at Madelia at 7:30pm. After receiving communion from Pastor Krista each church broke into their separate council meetings.

President Laurie Wille called the meeting to order.

Minutes from the previous month were approved.

Treasurer's Report was presented by Clayton. Checking Balance is \$7309, Savings Balance is \$54816 It was noted that Sept. we had a \$3713 gain, but in October we will have a \$3692 loss, most of that is due to paying 2 months of Pastor Krista's salary. Stewardship Report: Vern was not present, but Yvonne reported that the Pony Express packets and Time & Talent sheets are all ready to go for the Nov. 1st kickoff of the Stewardship drive. Laurie also asked that they include a sheet to introduce Pastor Krista and her family to all members of the congregation.

Lay Ministry: Yvonne reported that they had received many good responses from members and visitors at the Polka service and the Anniversary service. A Thank You will be sent to Waverly for the beautiful alter flowers they gave for the weekend. Installation service for Pastor Krista is still on hold as we are waiting for the Synod to let us know a date that will work for them.


Church Property: Brad reported that the new light bulbs have been installed at the West door of the church. He will be looking into installing a motion light at the south door for added light in addition to the street light. They are also looking into using more energy efficient bulbs in some of the larger fixtures, but a draw back to that is they cannot be dimmed. They plan to run the furnace at a lower temperature then before, so all members are urged to dress accordingly.

<u>Christian Education</u>: Nikki reported that Sunday School has been going good and that they have scheduled the SS Christmas program for Sunday December 13 during the worship service. It was also noted that the Choir will be performing on December 6th.

Youth: Teresa reported that the youth will be serving a supper on Election night, Nov. 3rd. Pastor Krista is also having a get-together at her house for the youth on Nov. 8th.

It was also brought up the need of spots for Wheel chairs at different pews. It was tabled till more research could be done. The need to keep all money in the office was discussed as there is money left in the boxes for a few days which is not secure. They will look into an area in the office for this purpose. Pastor Krista reported that the 1st Communion service will be on Nov. 1st the same day as the All Saints service. The 6 confirmation students really enjoyed the 1 Sunday a month for 3 ½ hours instruction time. The Stewardship drive will start Nov. 1st with "Walk with Jesus" as the theme. It was also noted that the Thankoffering service is set for Nov. 15th. Pastor Krista also handed out a detailed report on her activities for the last month.

# Thankful Hearts

Make table decorations that serve as Thanksgiving conversation-starters.

#### What you need:

- · Paper and pencil
- Scissors
- Cloth or felt
- Needle and thread
- · Sewing machine (optional)
- Fiber fill, cotton balls or rice
- Adult help



- Cut out a heart pattern (any size) on paper. Allow 1/4" for a seam if you'll be using a sewing machine.
- Cut out material hearts, placing pieces right sides out if sewing by hand and right sides together if using a machine.
- For hand-sewing, use a running stitch or an overcast stitch. Leave an opening for stuffing.
- 4. With a machine, sew along a 1/4" seam, allowing a 1" opening so you can turn the heart inside out and insert stuffing. Trim close to seam but don't cut stitching.
- Fill with stuffing. Sew the opening shut by hand.
- Put a heart at each place setting. Before dinner, have guests pick theirs up and say why they have a thankful heart.













### Scepter and crown

The scepter and crown are symbols of a king's authority. In Christian tradition, they represent Christ's triumphant rule over all. The final Sunday of the liturgical year — November 22 this year — is Christ the King Sunday, when we celebrate this very thing. Hebrews 1:8 (NIV), echoing the book of Psalms, reads: "Your throne, O God, will last for ever and ever, and righteousness will be the scepter of your kingdom."
