TRINITY CALL COMMITTEE UPDATE

Trinity Welcomes Pastor Krista Strum!

By a majority ballot vote, Sunday, August 23, 2015, the Trinity Lutheran Church, Truman, congregation supported the official hiring of Pastor Krista Strum. Trinity Truman is contracting with Trinity Lutheran Church, Madelia, for 50% of Pastor Krista's total service. She will conduct Sunday services at each church and conduct joint confirmation classes with Truman and Madelia students. Pastor Krista will establish regular office hours at Truman each week and will conduct visitations to members who are unable to attend services at Trinity Truman.

Pastor Krista's first worship day at Trinity Truman will be held 10:30 a.m. on Sunday, September 13, which is also Rally Sunday. At that date, she will begin her official duties in Truman. Initially it has been agreed between the two church councils that Madelia will schedule an 8:45 a.m. service and Truman will hold a 10:30 a.m. service. Service schedules will be annually reviewed by each council in June. Her installation day will be announced at a later date.

Pastor Krista (as she would like to be known) has most recently served at Word of Peace Lutheran Church in Rogers, MN. Prior to Luther Seminary, she received a Master's degree in education with an emphasis on special education. Since seminary she has served several congregations and has been at Word of Peace since 2011. On her resume, she lists her areas of expertise as Christian education, and youth and

family ministry. Pastor Krista considers her areas of strength to be teaching, innovation and creativity.

We welcome with joy to Truman Trinity Lutheran Church, Pastor Krista Strum, her husband, Matt, and daughters, Katherine (Katy), 10, and Lauren, 5!

minutes from previous meeting: were approved as read,

Clayton gave treasurer's report: · Checking balance stands at \$1,005.00; saving account balance at \$54,738. Vicar Kent's last paycheck was in July, not indicated in the August figures. A bill of \$313.83 was paid to Rode Manufacturing for new flagpoles for the front entrance. It was approved that Pastor Anderson be reimbursed for visitations based on his previous visitation services, with a small percentage additional amount. Karen Koeder will be paid at end of August for her pulpit service based on the Synod rate plus her mileage.

Lay Ministry: Yvonne reports that planning is well underway for the October 3, 2015 Polka Service. We want the 50th anniversary of our new building to be a service of celebration. Yvonne reports that previous

Trinity musicians will participate. Pastor Krista will perform the liturgy and children's sermon. Former Pastor Lyle Rich will offer the guest sermon. The service will be at 10:30 a.m. followed by a lunch served by Trinity youth. Special invitations for out-oftowners/previous members are being drawn up. Advertising for this service will be tied into the advertising for the Polka Service.

Church Properties: Brad Nickerson reported on an energy load management program we have signed onto with the Truman Public Utilities, which will control our various air conditioning units on an as-needed basis and should total around \$36 per month in utility savings.

Christian education: Nikki reports that VBS will be held August 26-27. The theme is "Plug Into Jesus's Power @ Trinity Lutheran's Power Lab." Children's choir will sing at the October 4th service; Sunday school will be held at 9:30 a.m. Rally Sunday is scheduled for September 13th—the same day as Pastor Krista's installation.

Youth: Teresa reports there will be a food and recreation pool party in later August for the Trinity youth.

Worship: Barb reports that Pastor Krista is planning on having confirmation jointly between Truman and Madelia students one day of the month, on Saturdays, for a three-hour session including breakfast.

Call committee: Yvonne reviewed the contract with Trinity Madelia for 50% of Pastor Krista Strum's services. The contract is available for the

congregation to review as



well. A congregational vote at Truman is scheduled after the service, August 23. Pastor Krista will start her Sunday duties at Truman on September 13. Motion passed for her contract. President Laurie Wille thanks the call committee for the work in securing Pastor Krista.

OTHER BUSINESS:

Laurie reports the Waffle Breakfast in July for Truman Days was a great success. After expenses, a projected profit of \$1,333.00 was realized. She would like to thank all the many volunteers who helped make this possible.

Vicar Kent's phone has been returned and bills settled.

Discussion was held concerning funds available through Thrivent. It was agreed to seek out Thrivent funding to help with Polka Service. Other ideas in the offing, as well. ELCA is discontinuing publication of The Lutheran magazine and The Little Lutheran due to lack of subscription activity.

A thank you note from Heaven's Table in Fairmont was received (this was funding from our Lenten services offering). Our \$506.67 donation enabled them to provide some 80,800 lbs. of food to the neediest folks in the area.

Next scheduled council meeting is September 9, 2015.

What you need:


- Apple

Nimbus

The nimbus is a halo of light often shown in art behind the head of a religious figure such as Mary, Joseph, the disciples, the four evangelists and so forth. Though often just a simple circle, one with three rays symbolizes the Trinity, so this style of nimbus — or a triangular one — may be seen behind Christ.


