Yvonne called the meeting to order. The secretary's report was read and accepted. Clayton presented the treasurer's report. There is \$5161 in the checking account and \$46,170 in the savings account. The month of June showed a net loss of \$2889. This has been a persistent trend and has become a matter of concern.

BOARD REPORTS:

Youth: Grant reported that the Youth Gathering trip had gone well. The kids were wonderful and involved in the activities. Worshipping with 30,000 energetic kids is an awesome experience! In 2021 the Youth Gathering will be held in Minneapolis. The youth will be serving their stakeholders meal on August 4 and they will participate in the church service on August 5. Church properties: There are several shrubs that have suffered from winterkill. Motion carried to pull out the dead shrubs and replace these areas with decorative rocks. Trinity is also looking for someone to trim our

shrubs. Doyle and Arlene have filled this capacity for many years and Doyle feels he needs to retire--and he has earned this right. We are very grateful to this great couple for this wonderful service to our church. **Christian education:** VBS will be held in Madelia on August 6-9. There will also be a leadership camp. Plans are still being made on holding Sunday School on Wednesday after school.

Worship: Sunday worship has started at 8:45. We will need pulpit supply pastors for 2 Sundays in August.

OLD BUSINESS: Yvonne and Grant have the waffle service organized. Workers still need to be contacted.

The Trinity parade entrant will be a pick-up with coolers of cold water. We are hoping there will be some youth that will help hand out the bottles.

Since pastor was absent, no firm plans were made concerning Sunday School being held mid-week.

Worship: Pastor Harold Peterson will be conducting our services on August 19 and August 26.

Pastor's report: Pastor is working on the curriculum for Confirmation. She is working with students in the Servant Leadership Camp as well as being involved with VBS. Pastor is putting together a curriculum for a new endeavor for Trinity--holding Sunday School on Wednesdays after school.

New business:

God's Work--Our Hands day will be September 9. Anyone who knows of a project that we can help with should call Yvonne or Brenda.

Because attendance has been so low for Sunday School, it was decided to try something new. Starting on September 12 we will be having Sunday School on Wednesdays.
