President Report by Dan Klassen. Many changes over the last year. Pastor Penny retired to part time Pastor Carol, hiring Ashley Parish as our Youth director, and supplying the Truman school pantry. We welcomed 11 new members and 6 baptisms, eight 1st communions, and presented one bible.
