It no longer matters to ICE and U. S. government if you are here legally, if you have papers, if you have a passport, or if your family has been legal residents for generations.

Our scripture calls us - to do justice, love kindness, and walk humbly with our God. (Micah 6:8) so let us pray for peace and justice, stand up for peace and justice, show our faces and protest for peace and justice.

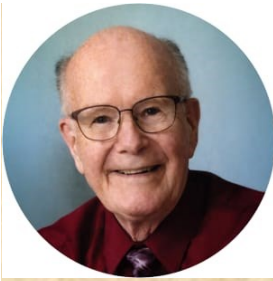
